





This word game is played by children and teens (even adults) in France.

The name "Baccalauréat" refers to a national French certificate earned at the end of secondary school, giving students access to higher education. Baccalaureate game is best played with family or friends.

CONTENT

Baccalauréat sheet template (print out one for each player)

Letters sheet (for players to select a letter)

Example sheet

HOW TO PLAY

- 1. Randomly pick a letter (with your eyes closed).
- 2. Cross out the letter once chosen.
- 3. Using your Baccalauréat sheet, find one word starting with the letter selected for each category.
- 4. Allow two minutes for each round or as agreed by players.
- 5. When the time is up, each player says the words found, add up their points, and write down their score.
- 6. Scoring: One (1) point per valid answer and category. Half a point (0.5) if two players have the same answer. No (0) point if more than two players have the same answer.
- 7. At the end of the game, each player works out their final score. The player who totals the highest final score is the winner. Ready? Set. Go!
